"These" e "those" são utilizados para mais de um objeto que estejam perto e longe do falante, respectivamente.

III. POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES AND PRONOUNS

"Possessive adjectives" são utilizados para qualificar um substantivo, estabelecendo uma relação de posse. Geralmente, localizam-se na frase próximos ao substantivo.

"Possessive pronouns" substituem o conjunto "possessive adjective + substantivo", evitando assim repetições numa mesma frase. Além disse, eles costumam estar no final da frase ou distantes do substantivo ao qual se referem.
